RULES FOR NEC MERIT SCHOLARSHIP

(Under the Scheme "Financial Support to the students of N.E.R. for Higher Professional Course" to be operated directly by the State of North Eastern Region)

A) Rules for FRESH NEC Merit Scholarship 2020-21:

Available in NSP as the cases for Fresh NEC Merit Scholarship is done through NSP from the current Financial Year 2020-21.

B) Rules for Renewal of NEC Merit Scholarship 2020-21:

1. Scholarship holders who have been promoted and got admission to the next higher class shall apply for renewal scholarship on a yearly basis.
2. The head of the Institution should recommend only the scholarship holders who are promoted and got admission to the next higher class.
3. Names of the Scholarship holders who are not promoted to the next higher class shall be removed from the list.
4. In case of a scholarship holder who failed in one or more subjects but promoted to the next higher class, his/her case for renewal of the scholarship shall be considered only after clearing the failed subjects in the next examination. His/her request for renewal shall be supported by a certificate from the head of the institution regarding his/her clearing of the backlogged subjects.
5. Scholarship holders who have changed their subjects/institution shall not be allowed to avail renewal scholarship further.
6. Scholarship holders who discontinue renewal of scholarship due to medical reasons may continue on submission of medical certificate from the District Medical Officer/ Head of a Medical Institution in this regard clearly indicating the Course and period of such break in study while applying for renewal.
7. Extension of scholarship beyond the prescribed period may be considered on merit of the reasons given in the certificate issued by Head of the Educational Institution in this regard.
8. M. Phil. Scholarship is sanctioned for a period one and half year and may extend for another 6 months on recommendation of the head of the Institution.
9. Scholarship for Ph.D. is sanctioned for a period of 3 years and may extend for another one year on recommendation of the head of the Institution.
