2. ELIGIBILITY:

- A. Candidates possessing the following qualifications in their respective subject/discipline are eligible for application for the posts except for Assistant Professor in Hindi for Hindi Teachers Training College (HTTC):
- A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the

- grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET:

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. Programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

OR

The Ph.D degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai

- B. A candidate desirous of applying for the post of Assistant Professor in Hindi for Hindi Teachers' Training College (HTTC) should possess the following qualifications:
 - i. Master's Degree in Hindi from a recognized Institute with a minimum of 55% marks;
 - ii. M.Ed. or Hindi Shikshan Nishant after B.T./B.Ed./Hindi Shikshan Parangat from a recognized University/Institute with a minimum of 55% marks;
 - iii. NET/SLET/SET or Ph.D. awarded in accordance with UGC Regulations, 2009.

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N.B:

- i. A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes (OBC)(Non-creamy Layer)/Differently- abled ((a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid-attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.
- ii. A relaxation of 5% shall be provided, (from 55% to 50% of the marks) to the Ph.D. Degree holders who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.

3. AGE LIMIT & OTHER ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:

- i. The age limit for the applicants may be fixed as per State Government norms i.e. 18 years to 38 years. The upper age limit may be extended by 3 years in case of OBC Candidates and by 5 years in case of SC/ST Candidates. Upper age for the candidates who are serving in the state Government may also be relaxed to the extent of the period of continuous service put in the post/service. A Government servant who belongs to OBC/SC/ST will get the facility admissible to a Government servant in addition to relaxation admissible to OBC/SC/ST categories
- ii. The candidate must be a permanent resident of Manipur, provided that a candidate whose parent or any of his/her ancestors in his/her direct lineage are permanent resident of the State, with proper documentary proof like enrolment in the electoral roll and birth certificate will also be eligible.
