

## Vision & Mission of the Scheme:

The main aim of this scheme is to equip the meritorious college students of the state belonging to the lower income group with the required digital device to take part in the online education which is an important mode of education in the present time. The Government and Government Aided Colleges of the state are imparting online education to the students at present under the supervision of the Department of Higher Education, Government of Manipur. Recently, the Department has launched MOODLE Learning Management System for the Government and Government Aided Colleges to facilitate effective transaction of online teaching-learning activities.

The students are taking part in the teaching-learning activities imparted online at a time when conducting physical classes in the colleges has become a challenge during this COVID 19 pandemic. In general, the digital device provided through the scheme will empower the students to step into the digital world and enable them to access the numerous services available in the virtual platform. This scheme will help the students of lower income groups to overcome the financial constraints faced in accessing online education. It will contribute in bridging the digital divide between haves and have nots in the society. The scheme will also act as a campaign to boost digital education in the state. It will go a long way in empowering today's youth to grow into productive citizens of tomorrow who can contribute immensely to nation building.

## Target Group and Eligibility:

### Target Group:

College students admitted to various non-professional Undergraduate Programmes in Government and Government Aided Colleges in Manipur and belonging to lower income groups.

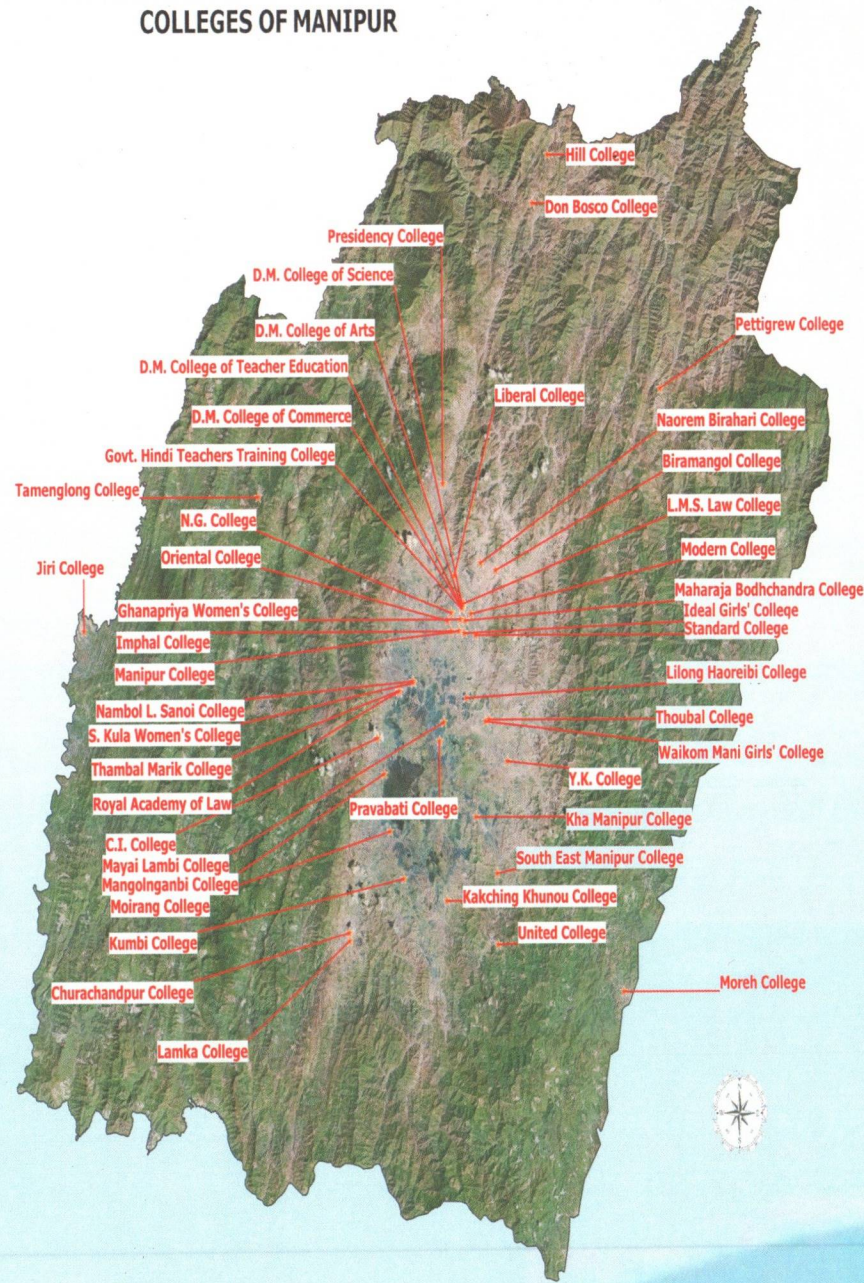
### Eligibility:

- The applicant must be a permanent resident of the State of Manipur.
- Children of Government /contractual employees are not eligible to apply.
- Students belonging to Below Poverty Line (BPL) families in all categories (General, ST, SC, OBCs) are eligible to apply.
- The students should be enrolled in any of the Government and Government Aided colleges in the State.
- Students reading in Masters Programmes in the colleges are not eligible for the scheme; and
- Only one student belonging to a family shall be eligible to be a beneficiary under the scheme.

## Documents to be submitted by the students to the college concerned:

- Application form in the prescribed format (online or offline).
- Admission details/ Aadhar Card/ Identity Card /Residential Proof/ Domicile Certificate/OBC or SC or ST Certificate/PWD certificate/Declaration of lone girl child/BPL/Income Certificate/Mark Sheets of Previous Year/ Passport Size Photograph etc.

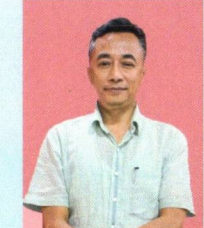

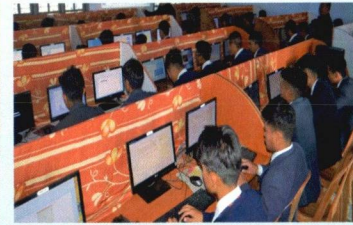
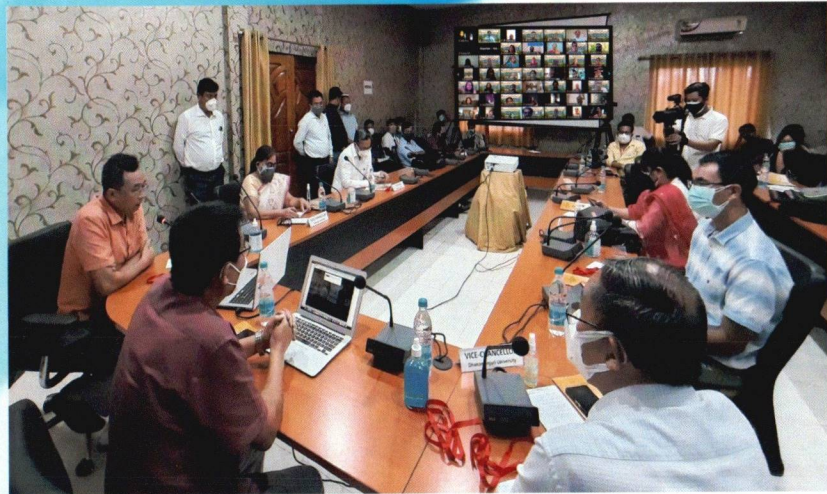


**Procedure of Implementing:**

- The eligible students will apply through their respective colleges. The college will constitute a committee to verify the eligibility and screen the students who have applied for the scheme. Mentors will be appointed to prioritize the students. The recommended details of the students in need of equipment would be uploaded in the college website and forwarded to the Directorate for final shortlisting of the students by a Committee.
- Purchase of new mobile devices will be conducted through open tendering.
- Distribution of devices will be done through colleges only.

- The Hon'ble Minister (Education), Manipur officially launched Moodle Learning Management System for 45 Govt. & Govt. Aided colleges in Manipur on 17th July in presence of Commissioner, Hr. & Tech. Edn. Govt. of Manipur, Vice-Chancellors of Manipur University & Dhanamanjuri University and the Director, UHE, Govt. of Manipur.
- Implementing Agency (SYNAPX, Solutions & Consultancy Services) has installed Moodle for all 45 colleges using 4 VPS (Virtual Private Server). Training has been provided to the Master Trainers for 45 colleges. The Master Trainers have trained other teachers of their respective colleges.
