

### Procedure of Implementation:

The Chief Minister's Award for Educational Excellence will be awarded in a State level function to be held on an important state/national day every year. The procedure for implementation of the Award will be as below:

- A Notification for submission of applications by the colleges will be issued by the Department of Higher Education, Government of Manipur.
- The colleges will apply to the Director, University and Higher Education for the Award along with all the supporting documents/photographs/videos.
- A Screening Committee duly constituted by the Department will screen all the applications received from the colleges and draw a merit list of the colleges based on the marks scored by them in different criteria/parameters.
- The recommended colleges will be formally approved by the Department of Higher Education.
- The award will be presented to the selected colleges on the State Level Teacher's Day.

### Fund/Budget of the Award:

The required expenditure for institution of the award will be earmarked in the Budget of the Higher Education Department in a separate Head of Account.

#### **Continuation of the Award:**

The presentation of the award will continue in successive academic years with effect from 2024-25 till such time as the Government decides to do so.

#### Introduction

It is through the development of strong sense and knowledge of their own cultural history, arts, languages and traditions that the students will be able to build a positive cultural identity and self-esteem for themselves in the future.

Today's students will be tomorrow's administrators, doctors, engineers, teachers and policy makers and therefore, it is important that we impart right education to our students today so to enable them develop right values for carrying on with the rich legacy of our land. We can build a robust society only when we instill right values to our students while they are learning in the educational institutions.

It is with this vision that the Department of Higher Education, Government of Manipur, is instituting a special award called 'Chief Minister's Award for Educational Excellence' for the college students of Manipur with effect from academic session, 2024-25. This initiative is meant to recognize and incentivize the Government and Government Aided Colleges of Manipur which excel in overall development of the students in all the aspects of learning domains/fields.

### Objectives

The objectives for the institution of the Award are:

- To encourage college students of Manipur to work harder for attaining higher learning standards;
- To encourage the students to learn arts, culture, literature, customs and traditions of the land and instill in them a sense of patriotism and love for the motherland while acquiring knowledge on various domains of study;





- To develop a conducive teaching-learning environment in the campuses of the colleges of Manipur; and
- To improve overall learning quality of the students in the colleges of Manipur to achieve the targets set by National Education Policy, 2020.



## **The Award Components:**

The Chief Minister's Award for Educational Excellence will be awarded to the Government and Government Aided Colleges of Manipur with good performances of the students in various fields. The Award comprises of the following components:

The criteria for selecting the colleges for winning the Award will be based on the marks scored by the colleges on various criteria/parameters. The criteria/parameters along with the weightage are as detailed below:
